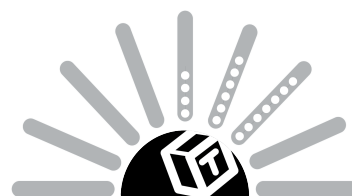

Items that will need to be included in your portfolio: Summary of Education, Family Questionnaires, Reflective Statements of Competence, Resource Collection and Professional Philosophy Statement. Need help? Contact one of our CDA Navigators.

Once your portfolio is finished, you have two applications to complete: the application to the Council and the application for a CDA[®] Assessment scholarship through T.E.A.C.H. The T.E.A.C.H. scholarship will pay 85% of the CDA Assessment fee. Contact one of our CDA Navigators at cda@iowaaeyc.org or email teach@iowaaeyc.org for assistance with these applications.
